Duties and Responsibilities

Reporting to the Director of Food Security, the Food Security Driver will be responsible for:

- Pick-up and delivery of food and meals to proper destination in a timely manner
- Checking in with manager for updates on progress and other information
- Maintaining timesheet
- Picking-up and returning rental truck
- On-call for pick-up of food donations
- Cleaning and maintenance of JFS truck
- Additional days/hours may be required occasionally, as needed
- Other tasks as assigned

Requirements and Qualifications

- A Valid Drivers License (class 5)
- Clean driving record
- Must be insurable
- Ability to lift boxes (up to 30-50 lbs.)
- Ability to drive a 15 ft. truck for periods up to five hours at a time



- Knowledge of truck operations: securing of vehicle and freight
- Must be computer literate
- Knowledge of safety regulations as per “Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations Manual” (training provided)
